MATERIALS

- 860-145 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Eggplant
2 Balls (A) **Vanna's Choice® (Article #860). 100% Premium Acrylic
400, 401, 403: 92% Acrylic, 8% Rayon
402: 96% Acrylic, 4% Rayon; package size: **Solids:** 3.5 oz (100 g), 170 yards (156 m)
Prints, Tweeds, & Heathers: 3 ozs (85 g) , 145 yards (133 meters)
Twists: 2.5 oz (70 g), 121 yards (111 meters)*
- 861-108 Lion Brand Vanna's Glamour Yarn: Lapis
3 Balls (B) **Vanna's Glamour® (Article #861). 96% Acrylic, 4% Metallic Polyester; package size: 1.75oz/49.61 gr. (202yds/185m) pull skeins*
- 861-186 Lion Brand Vanna's Glamour Yarn: Bronze
1 Ball (C)
- 790-404 Lion Brand Homespun Yarn: Lagoon
1 Ball (D) **Homespun® (Article #790). 98% Acrylic, 2% Polyester; package size: 6.00oz/170.00 gr. (185yds/169m) pull skeins*
- 790-399 Lion Brand Homespun Yarn: Apple Green
1 Ball (E)
- 755-201 Lion Brand Unique Yarn: Garden
3 Balls (F) **Unique (Article #755). 100% Acrylic; package size: 3.50oz/100.00 gr. (109yds/100m) pull skeins*
- 755-203 Lion Brand Unique Yarn: Passion Fruit
2 Balls (G)
- Lion Brand Size 11 [8 mm] 29-inch [75 cm] Circular Knitting Needles
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size K-10.5 (6.5 mm)
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)



GAUGE:

16 sts = 4 in. (10 cm) over pattern.

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

sk2p (slip-k2tog-pass slipped st over)

A double decrease worked as follows:

1. Insert right needle as if to knit, and slip the next st from the left needle to the right needle.
2. Knit the next 2 sts together.
3. With tip of left needle, lift the slipped st (the 2nd st on right needle) up and over the k2tog (first st on right needle) and off the needle - you have decreased 2 sts.

Yo (yarn over)

An increase that also creates a small decorative hole (eyelet) in the fabric, worked as follows:

1. Bring yarn to front, between the needles.
2. Take yarn to back, over the right needle. This creates the new st. You are now ready to proceed with the next st as instructed.

PATTERN STITCHES

Zigzag Pattern (worked over a multiple of 16 sts + 1 extra)

Row 1 (RS): K1, *yo, k6, sk2p, k6, yo, k1; rep from * across row.

Row 2: Purl.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 for Zigzag pattern.

NOTES:

1. Throw is worked with 1 or 2 strands of yarns.
2. A circular needle is used to accommodate the large number of sts. Work back and forth on circular needle as if working on straight needles.



THROW

With 1 strand each of A and B held together, cast on 129 sts.
Knit 3 rows.

Beg Zigzag Pattern

Rows 1-8: With 1 strand each of A and B held tog, and beg with Row 1, work in Zigzag pattern.

Rows 9-12: Change to 1 strand of D and continue in Zigzag pattern.

Rows 13-20: Change to 1 strand each of B and F held tog and continue in Zigzag pattern.

Rows 21-24: Change to 1 strand of E and continue in Zigzag pattern.

Rows 25-28: Change to 1 strand each of C and G held tog and continue in Zigzag pattern.

Rep Rows 1-28 three more times, then rep Rows 1-7 once more.

With 1 strand each of A and B held together, knit 3 rows.

Bind off loosely.

FINISHING

Fringe

Cut one 18 in. (45.5 cm) length each of A, B, C, F and G.

Hold strands together and fold in half. Use crochet hook to draw fold through one corner of Throw, forming a loop. Pull ends of fringe through loop and tighten.

Rep to work 17 fringes evenly spaced across each end of Throw.

Weave in ends.
