

St Patrick's Day Crafts:

Shamrock

Crochet Pattern

Two more days till Saint Patrick's Day. I'm excited. It will be a fun day. I'm planning to have friends over and we'll have a little Irish shamrock party!

I thought to make something fun & frivolous for everyone, like my personal St. Patrick's Day crafts. A shamrock boutonniere or aka green clover brooch. What do you think?



Like one too? OK.



Here is your illustrated free crochet pattern.



Shamrock Free Pattern

Set-up: attach yarn (leaving a 2" strand) and chain 8.

Row 1-5: begin in the 2nd st: sc every st, + ch 1 (= first sc of next row)

Row 6: 4 dc into the 3rd st, sl st in 5th, 4 dc into the 7th st, sl st at end of row.

Cast off.

Make 4.





Use the 2" strand to attach the left to the right half of the bottom of each leaf petal. It becomes heart shaped when you do. Just 3 st. is sufficient.

Now, with a blunt needle, string all 4 hearts onto a new thread of yarn. Tighten them together in a circle. Attach the petals with a few stitches to each other,

Done.
